



General Education Requirements

The following are courses that can be taken at WCTC to fulfill Carroll University degree requirements. Check the options for transfer with an Associate's degree. All students must fulfill General Education (G1 and G2) requirement areas at Carroll University. Consult the Carroll University catalog for clarification. Students may wish to enroll concurrently in the Carroll program.

Students should consult with the counselors at Carroll for a recommended progression of coursework in their chosen major. Students may wish to enroll concurrently in the Carroll program.

<u>Graduation Requirements:</u>

- 1) ENG 101 or 102. We require only one semester of composition. 801-136 meets this requirement.
- 2) The Bachelor of Science degree requires 804-189 and CMP 113 or 114 at Carroll or 804-198 and Computer Science 110 at Carroll. 804-189 or 804-198 may be specific for certain majors. Elementary Education students need MAT 104 & 201 and 804-189. The Bachelor of Arts degree requires the completion of one year of an international language (or the equivalent). Select programs require 2 years of an international language. Consult the Carroll catalog for details.
- 3) All students must demonstrate math proficiency at the 804-196 (Trigonometry) level or higher. Math statistics may substitute for this course (804-189).
- 4) A cross cultural experience and global perspectives colloquium are also required; to be completed at Carroll University. General Education (GE1 and GE2)

Students expand their knowledge outside their major area of study by completing one class in each of the four remaining distribution areas outside of their major area (G1). Students do not need to take an additional course in their major area (see distribution chart). Students must take a GE2 course in one of the four remaining distribution areas. One G1 or G2 course must also meet a cross-cultural designation (CCD). For additional options, students may wait to take these courses at Carroll.
