### Accounting Program

Carroll University's School of Business prepares you for a career in a variety of organizations and industries. We take a *real-world approach* and provide opportunities to meet and network with business leaders from around the region and across the country. A degree in accounting will give you the flexibility to use your skills in mathematics, communication, and relationship building in a variety of roles. This major pairs well with minors such as finance, actuarial science, computer science, information technology, and Spanish.

**Accounting Major w/CPA emphasis** – will need 150 credit hours to be eligible for the CPA exam. At Carroll, the accounting program with CPA emphasis aligns with curriculum requirements set by the National Association of State Boards of Accounting. For other certifications of interest, advisers will help plan.

#### General Education Requirements

All students must fulfill the Carroll University **Pioneer Core** requirements including:

**The five Cross-Cultural Components:** CCS199 Cultural Seminar, ENG170 Writing Seminar (ENG101 or 102 @ UWMilw - Waukesha), Cross-Cultural Development course (CCD), CCS300 Cross-Cultural Experience and CCS400 Global Perspectives Colloquium.

**The Distribution Component includes four** introductory level General Education 1 (G1) courses, and one higher-level General Education 2 (GE2) course, outside of their major. See chart on page 2 for suggested equivalencies. A GE2 course must be from the same discipline as one of the GE1 courses taken (e.g., GE1 English and a GE2 English course) or in a pre-approved cognate field.

Students will complete coursework in the Fine Arts, Humanities, Philosophy/Ethics/Religion, Social Sciences and Natural Science areas. Students earning an associate of arts or an associate of arts and sciences degree from UWMilw – Waukesha, will have fulfilled various components of the Pioneer Core. Please consult the Carroll University catalog or a Carroll University Admission Counselor for details.

### Additional Graduation Requirements

- **Convocation Program** – attendance at 2 events per year is required of all full-time students.
- Students must earn a minimum of 128 credits, with the last 32 credits completed at Carroll.
- Students must earn a minimum 2.0 cumulative grade point average, a minimum 2.0 Carroll University grade point average, and a minimum 2.0 grade point average within their major.
- One-fourth of the major requirements must be completed at Carroll University.
- A total of 64 credits may transfer from a two-year institution.
