



Full-time, tenure-track position in the Modern Languages and Literatures program

Starting Date: September 1, 2012

Qualifications: We are seeking an energetic, creative generalist in Spanish language and literatures to fill a tenure track position at the assistant professor level. Requirements include Ph.D. in hand as well as a documented record of scholarship and experience teaching language and literature (open to Peninsular, Latin American and/or Caribbean) at all levels of instruction. Preference given to candidates willing to teach a cross-cultural freshman seminar in our General Education program and to establish links with the local Hispanic community. The teaching load is 12 credits per semester (typically, three four-credit courses).

Rank and Salary: Assistant Professor, Tenure Track. Salary is competitive and commensurate with qualifications.

The Program: The Modern Languages and Literatures Program is part of the Department of English and Modern Languages, and is housed within the College of Humanities and Social Sciences. The program offers a major in Spanish and minors in French and German.

The College: The College of Humanities and Social Sciences includes the Department of Communication and Sociology, the Department of Education, the Department of English and Modern Languages, the Department of History, Politics, and Religion, and the Department of Visual and Performing Arts. The College offers a wide range of academic and interdisciplinary programs of study and serves as an integral component of the general education core requirements.

The University: Founded in 1846, Carroll University is an independent, co-educational comprehensive institution grounded in the liberal arts tradition. Carroll University is located in suburban Waukesha, 16 miles west of Milwaukee and 60 miles east of Madison. The University serves approximately 3,520 full-time and part-time undergraduate and graduate students. The University, though intentionally ecumenical and non-sectarian in approach, is related to the Presbyterian Church, USA.
