



Description: The Gladys McKay Richter Endowed Chair of Nursing

Starting Date: September 2012

Qualifications: BSN, MSN, and doctoral degree in Nursing or related field required. Current Registered Nurse licensure or eligibility for licensure in the State of Wisconsin is required.

Responsibilities: The Gladys McKay Richter Endowed Chair of Nursing, working with the Chair of the Department of Nursing, will develop and implement an advanced degree nursing program. Other responsibilities of the position include teaching, scholarship, and service. The successful candidate will have an established record of teaching, scholarship, and service in a College or School of Nursing at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. Curriculum and teaching responsibilities include nursing theory coursework and clinical or laboratory sections in the successful candidate's area of content expertise.

Rank and Salary: Commensurate with qualifications.

The Gladys McKay Richter Endowed Chair of Nursing was established by George Richter in memory of his wife, Gladys, a Carroll alumna from the class of 1936, and in honor of the outstanding nursing care she received over the course of her lifetime.

The Program: The Department of Nursing is in the College of Natural Sciences, Health Sciences, and Business. The department offers a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree and has approximately 290 students. The BSN program is approved by the Wisconsin State Board of Nursing and accredited by CCNE through December 2020. The department faculty members have a record of clinical scholarship/practice and service. A full-time laboratory staff member coordinates a state-of-the-art Nursing Skills and Simulation laboratory. Current practicum affiliations include health systems in southeastern Wisconsin and community health agencies.

The College: The College of Natural Sciences, Health Sciences and Business includes the Department of Computational and Physical Sciences, the Department of Life Sciences, the Department of Health and Human Movement Sciences, the Department of Nursing, and the Department of Business, Accounting and Economics. The College has received federal and private foundation grant awards and has offered multiple study abroad programs. The College has a strong staff of support personnel and laboratory coordinators.

The University: Founded in 1846, Carroll University is an independent, co-educational comprehensive university grounded in the liberal arts tradition. Carroll University is located in suburban Waukesha, 16 miles west of Milwaukee and 60 miles east of Madison. The University serves approximately 3,520 full-time and part-time undergraduate and graduate students. The University though intentionally ecumenical and non-sectarian in approach, is related to the Presbyterian Church, USA, employs a full-time chaplain and provides a spiritual life program.
