

Description: Full-time Tenure-track faculty position in Teacher Education

Starting Date: September 1, 2010

Qualifications: Doctorate in education, with an emphasis in literacy preferred; a masters in education or curriculum and instruction with an emphasis in reading/literacy required. Candidate must be certified or licensable as a reading specialist in Wisconsin. Previous college teaching experience in a teacher education program required. A minimum of three years of PK-12 classroom teaching required. Demonstrated expertise in teaching all areas of literacy at both the undergraduate and graduate level including the following:

- Developmental reading/literacy
- Emergent literacy
- Reading in secondary/middle school content areas
- Language arts
- Children and adolescent literature
- Assessment and diagnosis

Responsibilities: The teaching load is 12 credits each semester, with possible opportunities for summer teaching. Teaching responsibilities may include both undergraduate and graduate courses. Other responsibilities include advising, serving the program, division, and college; and scholarship.

Rank and Salary: Tenure track assistant/associate professor. Salary is competitive and commensurate with qualifications.

The Program: The Education program offers undergraduate majors in elementary education and educational studies, and minors in secondary education, early childhood education, and adaptive education. The Teacher Education program is DPI-approved. It is distinguished by a conceptual framework focused on preparing initial educators whose dispositions and practices demonstrate constructivism, cultural responsiveness, multiculturalism, curricular integration, and critical reflection. The Graduate Program in Education leads to an M.Ed. degree for teachers and other human service professionals. Both graduate and undergraduate programs maintain partnerships and student placement arrangements with urban, suburban, and rural schools, PK-12.

The University: Founded in 1846, Carroll University is an independent, co-educational comprehensive college grounded in the liberal arts tradition. Carroll University is located in suburban Waukesha, 16 miles west of Milwaukee and 60 miles east of Madison. The University serves approximately 2500 full-time and 800 part-time students. The University, though intentionally ecumenical and non-sectarian in approach, is related to the Presbyterian Church, USA and employs a full-time chaplain.
