

Description: Clinical Assistant/Associate Professor of Nursing – Maternal/Child Nursing and Medical Surgical Nursing

Starting Date: September 1, 2010

Qualifications: BSN and MSN required. Preference will be given to candidates with a PhD in Nursing and a documented record of teaching and clinical expertise. Current Registered Nurse licensure or eligibility for licensure in the State of Wisconsin is required.

Responsibilities: The primary responsibilities of the position include teaching, clinical, and scholarly activity, and program and university service. Teaching within the Nursing program includes Obstetrics and Pediatric nursing theory courses and a junior medical surgical nursing clinical practicum with weekly laboratory sessions.

Rank and Salary: Commensurate with qualifications.

The Program: The Department of Nursing is in the Division of Natural and Health Sciences. The department offers a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree and has approximately 275 students. The department faculty members have a record of scholarship and service. A full-time laboratory staff member coordinates a state-of-the-art Nursing Skills and Simulation laboratory. Current practicum affiliations include health systems in southeastern Wisconsin and community health agencies.

The Division: The Division of Natural and Health Sciences include the Department of Chemistry, Mathematics and Physics, the Department of Life Sciences, the Department of Health and Human Movement Sciences and the Department of Nursing. The Division has received federal and private foundation grant awards and has offered multiple study abroad programs. The Division has a strong staff of support personnel and laboratory coordinators.
