Purpose of Job:

- The student workers in the athletic training room fulfill a variety of responsibilities. The student workers responsibilities are affiliated with work study and campus work through the Office of Financial Aid. Those that are certified in First Aid and CPR and will assist in medical coverage for practices and events (home and away) in accordance with the American Red Cross standards.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Assisting and/or providing basic first aid
- Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)
- Activating the emergency medical system
- Prophylactic taping for ankles, wrist, thumb, fingers, arches, and toes
- Assist with basic stretching
- Event and practice set-up/clean-up
- Lifting and moving athletic training equipment (i.e. 10 gallon coolers of water, plinths, etc.)
- Cleaning of the athletic training room
- Administrative duties (i.e. Filing, record keeping, computer work, etc.)

Job Qualifications:

- Student workers must be eligible for work study through the Office of Financial Aid. Priority will be given to students majoring in the field of athletic training education.
