2. FINANCIAL STATEMENT

- Submit a bank statement and statement of support.
- International applicants must show proof of adequate finances to cover at least one academic year of study.

3. T.O.E.F.L or IELTS SCORES

- Have an official TOEFL or IELTS score sent directly from the company.
- The minimum required TOEFL score is: 79 IBT or 213 CBT or 550 PBT.
 - The institution code for Carroll University is 1101.
- The minimum required IELTS score is: 6.

4. TRANSCRIPTS (For all years of high school and any college or university work)

- Submit official copies with literal English translation of academic credentials.
- If applying as a transfer applicant seeking transfer credit, include English translations of course syllabi.
