## **Clinical Assistant Professor of Physical Therapy**

**Starting date:** July 1, 2018

**Responsibilities:** Responsibilities of this 12-month appointment are in the Doctor of Physical Therapy program and include teaching, scholarship, and service. All areas of clinical and teaching expertise will be considered for the position with preference given to candidates with clinical and/or teaching experience in one or more of the following areas: anatomy, introductory physical therapy examination, physical therapy treatment, evidenced based practice or professional issues. Candidates who have a documented record of teaching and professional service excellence, who are innovative and value a dynamic, integrated and comprehensive approach to physical therapy education, and who are seeking a vibrant, interdisciplinary working environment are encouraged to apply.

**Qualifications:** The ideal candidate is a physical therapist with an earned post-professional advanced degree or a DPT with evidence of contemporary clinical expertise and clinical specialist certification. Current physical therapy licensure or eligibility for licensure in the state of Wisconsin is required.

**Rank and Salary:** Commensurate with qualifications.

**The Department:** The hallmark of the program's mission is to educate students to become licensed physical therapists in an evolving and interdisciplinary healthcare environment. Interdisciplinary research initiatives and innovative local and international service learning programs support the mission. The direct admit Doctor of Physical Therapy Department is housed in the College of Health Sciences. The program is housed at the Carroll University Center for Graduate Studies, a 55,000 sq. ft. interdisciplinary graduate facility. This facility includes comprehensive teaching and state of the art laboratory spaces for both teaching and scholarly endeavors.

**The College:** The College of Health Sciences offers undergraduate and graduate programs through four departments—Health and Medicine, Human Movement Sciences (athletic training, exercise science, exercise physiology); Nursing; and Physical Therapy (DPT). Health sciences account for ~60% of the University enrollment. The mission of the College of Health Science is to educate students to be innovative professionals who collaborate to serve the health needs of their communities. A dynamic and growing entity, College-wide foci include interprofessional education and practice, the integrated approach to health, innovative learning and healthcare technologies, community partnerships and service to medically underserved populations.
