



Part-time Studies Scholarship Application 2022-2023

Scholarship Criteria

To be considered for the Part-time Studies Scholarship, the following criteria must be met:

- Applicants must be first-time, bachelor's degree seeking students.
- Applicants must be registered for a minimum of six (6) credits for applied term by scholarship deadline.
- The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA; fafsa.gov) form must be completed and on file with the Carroll University Office of Financial Aid (Institutional Code: 003838) by scholarship deadline.
 - *If you are not a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen and therefore ineligible for federal/state aid, please comment in personal statement.*
- Applicants must be in good academic standing (minimum GPA of 2.0)
- Applicants must receive minimal or no employer tuition reimbursement.
- Applicants must provide a personal statement as to why they think they are a good candidate for this scholarship, including any special financial circumstances, as well as one's academic pursuits.
- For scholarship consideration, completed applications must be received in the Admission Office by scholarship deadline.
