Under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, schools are required to notify financial aid applicants and recipients about the opportunity to have their financial aid file reviewed if their family was affected by a recent unemployment of a family member or independent student, or other extenuating, unforeseen circumstances.

If you or your family feel that the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) does not accurately reflect your current financial situation, please review, and complete the attached special circumstance form. Be sure to submit all requested documentation. If you are unsure if your situation qualifies, you may draft a letter/email explaining your situation and the change in your income (from 2019 to 2020 or 2019 to 2021) and a financial aid counselor will review and follow up with you if additional information is needed.

Please note that not all situations warrant an extenuating circumstances review, and not all requests for extenuating circumstances can guarantee additional funds for a student.
