
GIFT OPTIONS

- Cash or pledges: Carroll counts the full amount of your gift(s), including any matching funds from your employer.
- IRA QCD Gifts: Donors 70.5 and older can make gifts directly to Carroll from their IRAs and never pay any taxes. No itemizing required! Learn more and start your gift at carrollu.edu/ira.
- Stock or bonds: Carroll will recognize the current value of the asset when it is given.
- Wills, Trusts, and Retirement Plans: Carroll recognizes will and trust provisions and retirement plan benefits at face value and uses good-faith estimate when a percentage of the plan is in the provision.
- Life-income gifts: You can make a gift to Carroll that provides a fixed income for life AND supports Carroll students. Calculate your rate at carrollu.edu/cga.
