1-3 Exploring Sample Plans are designed to serve as a guideline for students who are undecided about their major and wish to explore their academic interests.

- Year 1 focuses on helping students explore introductory courses of interest and/or potential majors while completing Pioneer Core requirements.
- Years 2-4 provide a broader perspective, showing how students might transition into a declared major and progress toward degree completion.

These plans are not one-size-fits-all and should be seen as flexible tools. They are intended to be customized based on the student's unique interests, career goals, and academic background. Students are encouraged to work with their academic advisor to adapt the sample plans to fit their personal circumstances.

Note that majors outside of the below are possible but may require additional semesters to accommodate unique course sequences or requirements.
